"Early condition identification, stabilization and prehospital interventions, and initiation of actions within the regional systems of care provide patients with the best chance for receiving expedient definitive therapies leading to optimal outcomes and maximized quality of life."

Mission: Lifeline® emphasizes a fully integrated system of care – from the initial 911 call and on-scene EMS treatment to seamless coordination with hospital-based emergency and cardiac services. EMS agencies receiving this recognition are acknowledged for their ability to quickly identify cardiac and stroke emergencies, initiate appropriate care, and reduce treatment delays through close collaboration with receiving hospitals.

"The American Heart Association Mission: Lifeline EMS awards are an important way to recognize the crucial roles and performances of EMS personnel in stroke and cardiac patients' care," continued Kronenfeld.

EMS professionals play a critical role in the chain of survival. AmeriPro clinicians begin assessment and treatment as soon as they arrive on scene – often up to one hour sooner than if a patient traveled to the hospital by car. Crews are trained to recognize the signs of severe cardiac and stroke emergencies, initiate life-saving interventions, and ensure patients are transported quickly to the most appropriate facility for advanced care.

"High-quality emergency cardiac and stroke care is built on strong clinical leadership, standardized protocols, and coordinated teamwork across the EMS system," said AmeriPro Health Director of Clinical Services Joshua Worth. "As a medical command provider, we are committed to ensuring our clinical oversight, communication, and evidence-based practices support EMS teams in delivering the right care at the right time."

Mission: Lifeline® is the American Heart Association's national initiative to advance systems of care for patients with high-risk, time-sensitive conditions such as severe heart attacks and strokes.
